**EDUCATION REVIEW OFFICE VISIT**

Wiri central School will be receiving a visit from the Education review Office (ERO) on 4 - 6 March. The Education Review Office is part of the Ministry of Education whose role is to review schools and check on the quality of school programmes and operations. The Board of Trustees and staff welcome the opportunity to show what we are doing well and receive feedback on ways we can continue to improve.

**EATING INSIDE**

At Wiri Central School we eat inside. Students receive free fruit every day, this is eaten in class at 10.30am, just before going out for the morning tea break. Lunch is eaten in classrooms at 12.45 - 1.00pm, before students go out to the play. As well as demonstrating whanaungatanga by sitting and

eating together, eating inside helps keep our school grounds clean and tidy. This expectation also applies before school and after school - only eat inside.

### STATIONERY

School stationery needs to be purchased through Warehouse Stationery Ltd at Manukau. The board of trustees does not ask families to pay a school donation/fee and provides many additional stationery items and resources required for learning. We therefore expect all students to purchase the stationery items required for their learning. Warehouse Stationery have all the details of the stationery required for Wiri Central students, just tell them your child's year level. Please support your child's learning by making this a priority.
