

INVERELL AVE ROAD WORKS

Thank you for your continued patience while the road works in Inverell Ave are impacting students' arrival and leaving from school. Your support to keep all our children safe is greatly appreciated.

MANA KIDZ- SCHOOL-BASED HEALTH SERVICE

The Mana Kidz programme is a school-based health service. It has been operating at Wiri Central School for many years and is supported by the Counties Manukau Public Health Nurses. Our Mana Kidz service operates most mornings at school. The service screens consented students for sore throats and skin conditions and can support students and whānau with other medical care if required. Our Mana Kidz support worker (Nita Stanley) and Public Health Nurse (Saane Muimuiheata) work closely with parents and the school. SCHOOL COSTS

Our school has opted into the Government School Donations Scheme. We do not ask for any school donations or day trip fees from parents. School stationery is provided to each student. If your child requires money for any other purpose, you will be informed via the newsletter or a note will be sent home for the required amount.

The school heavily subsidises the Year 6 and Year 8 camps however, we ask parents to contribute \$100 towards the cost. These are the only excursions we ask parents to pay a fee towards. While the camps cost the school a considerable amount of money, the experience for the students is well worth it.

BIKES, SCOOTERS AND SKATEBOARDS

Students are not permitted to bring bikes, scooters or skateboards to school as we do not have appropriate storage for these during the school day. If your child brings a bike, scooter etc to school we will require a parent/caregiver to come and collect it.

The school has several small-sized bikes that were donated. These are used by Year 0-3 classes to teach safe riding as part of our school curriculum. Students are required to wear a helmet and closed-in shoes when riding the school bikes. Occasionally we might hold a special event where students are permitted to bring bikes, scooters etc - we will let you know of this in advance via the newsletter and an individual notice. At these times we will make special arrangements for storage and safety routines.

YEAR 7/8 PRESEASON NETBALL TOURNAMENT

Netball Manurewa is providing a free tournament for interested teams. Games are on Tuesdays at 4:15pm. The tournament starts on 5 March and goes until 9 April.
