

Foodbank Information - 2 April 2020

Here is some current information on foodbanks still operating during the COVID19 Level 4 lockdown.

Auckland City Mission foodbank is still open but slightly different process. If you need a food parcel you have to call ACM 09 303 9266 and speak to the Crisis Care team who will do a phone interview. Clients will then be given a time to collect from ACM distribution centre at 15 Auburn street, off Boston Road in Grafton - Clients must take their ID with them.

Salvation Army food parcels - NOT accepting walk ins. Hours are: 10am - 3pm Mon - Fri. Client needs to contact Salvation Army Community Ministries 09 379 7615 Mt Wellington, Manukau Salvation Army Community Ministries 09 262 2332 or your local Ministry on 0800 53 0000. Client/Support Worker will be interviewed over the phone, and instructed from there of process. Client/Support Worker will need to pick up food parcel in most cases from local foodbank.

Presbyterian Support Northern 09 309 2054 - pick up 8 Madeira Lane, Grafton. A form needs to be completed and emailed in by 10am (phone for details), strictly no walk-ins. Collections are between 11-12pm Mon-Fri. Only one person being let in at a time when collecting parcels.

MUMA, Manukau Urban Maori Authority - Mon-Fri, open 1000-1400 - 09 2777 866. Client has to go down to Marae at 31 Calthorp Close, Favona with ID or staff with details of clients. Wait in car and staff will get to each person one at a time, asking relevant questions as needed.

Papakura Marae Foodbank - Open Mon-Fri 1000-1430, 09 297 2036. Clients have to phone to request a food parcel, someone will ring them back to do a phone interview, then food will be delivered but only to Papakura and Manurewa areas currently, although this might change to designated pickup times.

Mt Wellington Foodbank at Mt Wellington CAB - 0800 367 222 - all CAB offices are closed, but they are responding by phone.
