Kia ora koutou, talofa lava, malo e lelei, kia orana, fakaalofa lahi atu, bula vinaka, and greetings,

We are continuing at Alert Level 3 until midnight on 26 August. This means you should keep your child at home if you can and continue learning from home. You should only physically send your child to school if you are an essential worker and have no one else to care for them. Children who need to come to school will be completing the same learning at home activities as those who are at home.

If your child (or someone in your bubble) has a health condition that means they are at a greater risk of a severe illness, you must keep them at home. If your child is sick please also ensure you keep them at home. We will continue to support learning at home. In order to ensure the safety of our staff and any students who do have to come to school, we will be operating with strict enforcement of health and safety measures. In order to plan appropriately it is essential that you let us know if your child must return to school on Monday. You will need to contact the school by phone on 0272620594.
