## SCHOOL BOARD ELECTIONS

Every three years all public schools in Aotearoa hold elections for their School Boards, and this is going to happen again in 2025. Our election date is 10 September.

The School Board is a key part of Wiri Central School because they do a lot of things behind the scenes that while they may not be visible, are really important to keeping our school running. Our board is made up of 5 parent representatives, the Principal and a staff rep elected by the staff.

The board need to appoint a Returning Officer, who is responsible for the running of the election and we have appointed Election Pilot as the Returning Officer for our election and to enable the election to be provided online. Election Pilot have been assisting schools with elections for over 20 years and have been accredited by the Ministry of Education to provide online election services. Important information like the nomination and voting forms will be sent to you by email directly by Election Pilot. If we don't have an email address for you, Schooled Election Pilot will send these out to you by post.

Your name and contact details have been provided to Election Pilot to enable them to deliver election services for our school as required by legislation. They will use your contact details for the provision of election services for Wiri Central School only and your details will be deleted 60 days after the election date as required by legislation. If you have any questions about the election process, then the best people to talk to are the team at Schooled Election Pilot. We will continue to keep you updated through the various stages of the election process.
